Pentagon Renovation Program

The Pentagon Renovation Program is responsible for renovating the headquarters of the United States Military, which has not undergone a major renovation since its original construction in 1941.

Pentagon Highlights:

- 🏠 Constructed in 16 months, from September 1941 to January 1943.
- 🏠 Encompasses 6.5 million square feet of building space.
- 🏠 Covers 29 acres with a 5-acre center courtyard.
- 🏠 Reinforced concrete was used to preserve steel for the war effort. 41,492 concrete columns support the building.
- 🏠 Hazardous materials are prevalent throughout the Pentagon.
- 🏠 The Pentagon does not meet any current building codes and it is not ADA compliant.
- 🏠 The Pentagon was declared a national historic landmark in 1992.
